## TEACHING WWII & THE HOLOCAUST IN THE CLASSROOM

**13-18 JULY 2025  
CAPE TOWN**

**T**he Cape Town Holocaust & Genocide Centre invites high school history educators across Southern Africa and beyond to apply for our **Residential Educator Training Programme in Cape Town, from Sunday 13th – Friday 18th July 2025.**

This full-time, week-long programme is designed to equip and empower in-service high school history educators to teach the subject of **World War Two & the Holocaust,**

**as well as 19th Century Pseudoscientific Theories of Race,** in their classrooms. The content of the course supports the South African National Curriculum requirements, and is **SACE-Approved.**

There will be a focus on working with primary sources, creating engaging group-work activities for learners, and exploring the history of the Holocaust in depth. There will also be an opportunity to look at the case studies of

**Apartheid and the Genocide Against the Tutsi in Rwanda**, as it relates to racism and human rights.

Educators will broaden their knowledge, model various classroom methodologies and activities, and be supported in creating a classroom environment that encourages **enquiry, sensitivity and compassion**.

On completion of the training, each participant **will receive:**

## OUTCOMES

- Participants will be empowered to teach the National History curriculum in their classrooms, using a range of **sources, methodologies and strategies** to engage learners.
- Participants will broaden their **knowledge** of this period in history, and grow their confidence in teaching this sensitive and complex subject matter.
- Participants will be equipped to become **ambassadors** and to assist the Cape Town Holocaust & Genocide Centre in coordinating future Educator Training Workshops in their district.
